FAQs

What is a food cooperative (co-op)?

According to the Neighboring Food Co-op Association (NFCA) a co-op is “an autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly owned and democratically controlled enterprise.” Though the structure and activities of specific co-ops may vary, most co-ops’ activities are governed by these guiding principles.

What does it mean to become a member-shareholder?

Your investment in the Co-op helps us meet our mission, and connects you to the Co-op community. At the end of each year, a portion of any surplus Co-op funds will be reinvested in the Co-op, and the balance may be rebated to members based on patronage. The more you spend, the more you get back.

Can anyone shop at the Mohawk Harvest Co-op? YES!

The Co-op is open to all. We invite non-member-shareholders to shop here. However, member-shareholders receive special benefits and discounts.

How much is a membership?

A one-time investment of \$150 gives you a **LIFETIME** membership in the Co-op. This amount may be paid in full or in installments. As soon as you complete your membership payments you receive full membership benefits and discounts.
