



## ***Mohawk Harvest Cooperative Seed Order***

Coop members and patrons,  
2020 marks the return of our cooperative seed order through [Fedco Seeds](#). Fedco is a small cooperative seed company in Maine. They provide cold-hardy seeds appropriate for our northeast climate and are committed to supporting a sustainable, organic and local seed supply. As a cooperative, consumers own 60% of the company; workers own 40%. This means that Fedco is not focused on profit but rather on providing top quality seeds at fair prices for farmers, workers and consumers.

As a cooperative, Fedco understands the power of working together and encourages cooperative ordering in our communities. By combining our orders, we can take advantage of volume discounts.

Deadline for orders is **January 31, 2020**. Please follow the directions below.

Here is how you can participate:

- 1) Go to <https://www.fedcoseeds.com/seeds/>
- 2) Log in to begin creating an order
  - a. Enter your own email address and zip code
- 3) Create your order by adding seeds to your cart
- 4) When you are done creating your order go to your cart
  - a. Click "part of a group"
  - b. Indicate whether you will accept substitutions
  - c. Indicate whether you will accept conventional for organic seeds
  - d. Click "check out securely"
  - e. **Enter group number: 99007**
  - f. Fill out your contact information (note: the seed order will be sent to the coop NOT to your address)
  - g. Click "continue"
  - h. Check your order information. You can continue to work on your order over many days (up to our deadline... see above).
  - i. Click "place order". Once you have done this, there is NO going back and editing the order. Your order is NOT complete and will not be included in the group order until you have clicked this button.
- 5) Submit your payment to the coop by **check made out to Mohawk Harvest Cooperative Market**. We must have your check in the store by the deadline (see above).

6) Your share of any volume discount will be returned to you as in-store credit.

If you prefer to peruse a hard copy of the catalog, a limited number are available in the coop.
